

Literacy

In Literacy, children will write:

- Instructions to play a made up game designed by children.
- Playscripts about different scenarios in school

Children will also write about their thoughts and feelings about Transition to secondary school as they explore their Hopes and Fears.

Children will develop Speaking and Listening / Drama skills as they prepare for the end of year performance.

Performance

Children will prepare for their end of year performance, 'Snow White and the Seven Dwarves'.

They will audit for parts, learn their lines and look at ways to improve their delivery. Children will also prepare costumes, dances and routines and scenery backdrops.

Business Challenge

Children will complete a 'Business Challenge' project in school.

Children will work in groups to set up a small business activity to raise money. Children will produce persuasive a leaflet / poster, a logo / name, a focussed Business plan and then produce a product and evaluate profits made.

Memory Books

Each child in Year Six will produce a wonderful 'Memory Book', celebrating their time with us at Horton Mill. Children will explore their memories using words, drawings, photographs and comments made by other children.

Maths

Maths learning for the remainder of the year will focus on targeting children's specific maths gaps before they move to secondary school.

We will continue to look at ways to move children from Level 3 to Level 4, from Level 4 to Level 5, and explore some of the secondary Level 6 curriculum with those who are ready.

Science

Children will complete a wide range of investigations revising different science topics, in preparation for secondary school.

Investigations will be based on:

- Friction
- Separation
- Dissolving
- Air resistance, and
- Water resistance

Computing

Children will produce a Power-point presentation about their business plan and ideas. Children will take photographs for their Memory Books.
