Literacy

Stories with Familiar Settings

Sharing, reading and writing stories about places children are familiar with e.g. the park, the library, the town.

Recount Writing

Children can write about events that have happened in the past that they have experienced.

Guided Reading Phonics

Maths

Count from 0 to 100 forwards and backwards. Recognise the place value of a 2 digit number Recall and use number facts to 5 and 10. Know 1 more than and 1 less than any number within 100.

Count in ones and tens.

Begin to add and subtract numbers and write the sum. Name and describe 2D and some 3D shapes. Measure the length, weight and mass of different objects using non-standard units.

Science

Animals including humans

Children will learn about the human body and be able to name lots of different body parts. They will learn about different animals including birds, fish and reptiles.

They will take part in investigations around our five senses and be able to answer questions about what they find out.

Art/DT

Children will have the opportunity to focus on their face and draw and paint a self-portrait.

Children will be introduced to different techniques such as shading and colour mixing with paint.

They will make a collage of the Queen also.




Children will learn about how to use computers safely. They will learn how to stay safe online and be able to turn the computer on and off.
