

Literacy

Stories by Significant Authors

Children will be sharing stories by different authors including Nick Butterworth and Martin Waddell and writing their own stories about where they live.

Word Play Poetry

Children will use different words to write poetry about our local park.

Guided Reading

Phonics

Maths

Subtraction using counters, objects and number lines.
Children will use the correct signs to write their sums.

Sequencing and sorting objects into groups and creating patterns using numbers and shapes.

Fractions including halves and quarters.

Money – 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p.

Time – Children will use morning, afternoon, evening and night to sequence a day.

2D and 3D shapes – Children will name and describe shapes and make shape pictures.

Science

Seasonal Changes – Autumn/Winter

Children will learn about the seasons of Autumn and Winter and their importance. They will walk to Alexandra Park to see the seasonal changes happen and learn about the animals in the park.

They will take part in investigations around our seasons and be able to answer questions about what they find out.

Art/DT

Children will explore different construction tools and materials to make 3D models and sculptures of buildings in London.

They will work in teams to plan, design, create and build their models. They will evaluate their work and discuss how to improve it.

Geography/History

London
