Recall 6x and 9x multiplication and division facts.

Use place value & known facts to divide mentally.

Partition numbers into multiples of the divisor.

Multiply 2-digit and 3-digit numbers by a single digit.

Use estimation and inverse to check answers to calculations.

Solve problems involving adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing (including remainders).

Estimate, compare and calculate different lengths.

Measure & calculate the perimeter of rectilinear shapes in centimetres and metres.

Convert between different units of measure.

Interpret and present discrete and continuous data using appropriate graphical methods.

Solve problems using information presented in graphs.
